

Announcement

The Australasian Society for Psychophysiology (ASP) has reached an agreement with the Publisher and Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Psychophysiology (IJP) for a **Special Issue of IJP in 2013** of papers arising from **ASP2012**.

Authors of interesting abstracts demonstrating cutting-edge techniques and important results will be invited to work up their paper for inclusion in the Special Issue. Outstanding presentations of papers not initially selected will also be invited to participate.

ASP will set up an Editorial Committee to work proactively with invited authors to ensure that their papers are at the high standard required for publication in IJP. The ASP Editorial Committee will make the final decision on acceptance of papers for the Special Issue.

Accepted papers in the Special Issue may contain up to four colour figures each at no charge.

The Introduction/Editorial for the Special Issue will include a Supplementary Information file including the Abstracts of accepted peer-reviewed papers from ASP2012. The published Abstracts will be permanently available online from IJP/Elsevier and the ASP website.

This is a great opportunity for members of ASP, and we hope that potential presenters at ASP2012 enthusiastically take up this offer to showcase Australasian Psychophysiology to the world.
